Dear Mr Millen,

Thank you for your email.

Unfortunately there were no minutes taken at the meeting as it was relatively informal.

We discussed the outstanding issue with the Vehicle Classification System element of the VIS, which Vindex are working to repair under instruction of Goodman's, who are responsible for this element.

The ITS team are in close communication with Vindex and Goodman's and are being kept updated of progress. As it stands the Vehicle Classification System hardware is confirmed as functioning in terms of it detecting vehicles entering/leaving the Business Park, however the actual classification of the vehicles is a software function and it continues to incorrectly classify all vehicles as HCV's. This issue is still to be rectified and instructions are ongoing in that regard.

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Vindex are however in the process of manually reviewing all the potential violation records. This entails someone sitting at a terminal and visually reviewing every single photo record. As you can appreciate, it is a laborious process and will take time.

Also discussed how frustrated the residents are about the amount lorries going through their villages

Dear Mr Testall,

Thank you for your email of the 27th July and for establishing the contact with the County Council. I will seek Stuart Morton's assistance as you suggest on the technical aspects of the scheme.

I am sure you will agree that the situation over enforcement is far from satisfactory; I note in passing that Clause 2.2 of the S106 agreement appears to deal with the point . I would be grateful, therefore, if you could advise me what steps are being taken to resolve the impasse. I note that Clause 12 of the S106 agreement contains provision for expert determination; there is also the possibility of seeking jointly an opinion from Queen's Counsel .Another option might be joint enforcement action.

I assume you wish to keep this issue confidential from Goodmans and will delay reporting this exchange publically until you respond with an explanation of how you propose to resolve the problem.

Dear Mr Millen

Please accept my apologies for the delay in your receiving a reply to your emails.

I have, of course, previously advised you that we were seeking to reach a mutual understanding with HCC of the legal position that they had adopted in relation to this matter. Whilst the County Council and the Borough Council are in agreement on a number of issues, we have been unable to reach agreement on the question of enforcing the restrictions in the section 106 agreement relating to HCVs entering the Andover Business Park site via the Barred Routes and via Monxton Road. It is

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the Borough Council's view that the responsibility for such enforcement falls to the County Council as the local highway authority.

I appreciate that this situation does not help you, and I can only apologise for that. I have today spoken to a HCC officer who indicated that they would be happy to answer questions about the system and all the related issues. These would be received by their Strategic Transport Team Leader, Stuart Morton [<mailto:Stuart.Morton@hants.gov.uk>]

I am sorry that I have not been able to write to you in more positive terms.
